**PROPOSED CHANGE OF THE AGE-RANGE OF STONE BAY**  
**(COMMUNITY SPECIAL) SCHOOL, BROADSTAIRS.**

**Update – Decision – 10 June 2019**

As no objections or comments were received to the public notice published on 8 May, Mr Roger Gough, Cabinet Member for Children, Young People and Education has confirmed his decision taken under procedures laid down in Kent County Council's constitution that the proposed changes to Stone Bay can be implemented from September 2019. The Canterbury Church of England Diocese and the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Southwark may appeal to the Schools Adjudicator against this decision within four weeks of the decision being made.

**Update May 2019 - Public Notice**

On 28 March 2019 the Children's, Young People and Education Cabinet committee recommended that the Cabinet Member issue a public notice in respect of the proposal to change the age range of Stone Bay Special School from 8-19 years to 5-19 years.
