

Key priorities for the School Plan 2019 – 20

Quality of Education

Develop a curriculum that is engaging, creative and ambitious and designed to give all pupils the knowledge and cultural capital they need to succeed beyond Stone Bay

Embed KS1 provision at Stone Bay School, fully immersing pupils in an ASD supportive environment at the start of their formal education.

Further strengthen the quality of teaching across the whole curriculum

Embed a system that effectively captures pupil journeys through the triangulation of holistic needs/communication and personal goals

Behaviour and Attitudes

Develop a whole school approach towards Mental Health and Well-Being for all stakeholders

To develop opportunities for peer to peer support for different groups of pupils

Develop pupils' understanding of the fundamental British values of democracy, individual liberty, the rule of law and mutual respect and tolerance

Personal Development

Develop Pupil Voice and links to Ethos and values through working towards Silver Level of the Rights Respecting School Award, pulling threads through the 24-hour curriculum

To provide all students with a wider range of opportunities to nurture and develop their talents and interests.

Continue to develop and extend opportunities for pupils to learn outdoors, onsite and offsite, provide a wider variety of activities and resources to support pupils' well-being and engagement

Leadership and Management

Build leadership capacity at all levels that contributes to sustained school improvement.

Ensure leaders engage with staff across all teams and are realistic and constructive in the way they manage well-being and workload

Ensure that practice and subject knowledge is built up and improved over time and all staff have access to high quality high quality CPD

Promote the expertise of the school across the wider community by providing outreach support and fully engaging in the lift process

Complete the process to become a full member of the Kent Special Education Trust.

6th Form Provision

Ensure the 6th form curriculum offers all students the opportunity to make choices in preparation for adult life

Extend work experience/enterprise opportunities within and beyond the school setting.
